## Iwona Wróbel: Integration of Railway Public Transport in the Aspect of Train Connections in Minor Stations

On the example of three hub stations Dęblin, Szczecinek and Zbąszynek, there was presented an analysis of train connections as an element of railway passenger transport integration. The overview of historical data from old train timetables (2014/15 and 2015/16 editions) and the current binding timetable (rjp 2016/17) allowed the assessment of such basic parameters as the number of inter-voivodship trains, the number of connections to destinations defined in the Transport Plan, the average waiting time and average connection time for these hub stations and particular destinations. Outlining the trends of changes allowed assessing the railway transport offer performed in public service.
